Purpose:

Dixie Technical College offers many types of scholarships to students based on specific criteria. To apply for a DIXIE TECH scholarship, download and complete the DIXIE TECH scholarship application. The scholarship application must include: a short essay stating why you are a deserving recipient of a scholarship and for current students: a professional recommendation letter from your instructor or for future students: a professional recommendation letter from someone who can attest to your professional behavior. The DIXIE TECH scholarship committee meets on a monthly basis to review scholarship applications. Award status notification will be given via email and mail. You can contact Student Services at 435-674-8400 for more information.

Application Deadlines:

- DIXIE TECH Scholarships are due by the 15th of the month
- DIXIE TECH Bridge Scholarship applications are due by April 15th

Scholarship Information:

- The College does not pay scholarship awards retroactively
- Incomplete applications will not be considered
- Students awarded a scholarship must maintain the minimum satisfactory standards in progress and attendance for the school or program (whichever is higher)
- Failure to maintain satisfactory progress and/or attendance during the scholarship award period may result in withdrawal of the scholarship award
- Applicants will be notified by mail and email of their selection status
- Students must officially accept the scholarship by letter addressed to the scholarship committee and submitted to Student Services

Selection Process:

The Dixie Technical College Scholarship Committee will review complete applications for consideration and identify those students to be awarded scholarships based on, but not limited to, the following criteria:

- Accomplishments in Applied Technology Education: grades, competency levels, and participation in student organizations
- Applied Technology Education Goals: the student's career goal is in line with previous and proposed training and students shows a commitment to the training field
- Other Achievements: general academics, community service, work experience, etc.
- Strength of Recommendations: Recommendations should provide specific and unique information that assists committee members in distinguishing the student's capability and merit.

Required Documentation:

- Complete Dixie Technical College Scholarship Application, including any supporting documentation (ex. Transcripts).
- A letter (at least 500 words) describing in detail why you should be considered for a DIXIE TECH scholarship, including: career goals, financial needs, and tell us about yourself
- Professional Reference Letter
 - Current Students: a reference letter from your instructor
 - Future Students: a reference letter from someone who can attest to your character
